

# Provincial Toilet Replacement Rebate Program

## **How to receive your rebate:**

For each replacement toilet, ensure your old toilet has a flush volume of at least 13 litres per flush.

Purchase and install a new CSA- (or "C"-) approved 6 litre or less flush toilet after January 1, 2009.

To prevent re-use of your old high-flush volume toilet(s), properly dispose of it in accordance with local landfill rules.

Submit the original sales receipt, which clearly indicates that a low-flush model toilet has been purchased (photocopied or duplicate receipts will not be accepted).

Submit copies of your receipts for installation fees if applicable.

**It is recommended that a copy of the sales receipt(s) and of the completed application form be retained for your records.**

Fill out and mail the completed application form with the original sales receipt(s) and copy of installation receipt(s) (if applicable) to the Saskatchewan Watershed Authority Head Office in Moose Jaw OR drop off the completed form at a Saskatchewan Watershed Authority office in your area.

The application will be reviewed for eligibility, and Saskatchewan Watershed Authority personnel may ask to inspect the installation. Once accepted, the Saskatchewan Watershed Authority will issue a cheque for \$50 for each eligible toilet replacement (no more than three toilets per single-family home will be rebated). The original sales receipt(s) will be returned to the applicant.

The funding available in each fiscal year is limited; however, a receipt held by the purchaser (who has met all eligibility requirements) may be eligible for a rebate in the following year.

**NOTE: If applying for rebates for low-flush toilet installations in multiple locations, please supply one completed rebate form per location.**
